SEEDS Summit to Feature Baldwin School, County Officials

SEEDS, Daphne's education foundation, will host an informational meeting on Baldwin County's school funding crisis on **Tuesday evening, Oct. 13, at Daphne High's Trojan Hall, beginning at 6:30 p.m.** Board of education president Tracy Roberts will provide an update on the district's new budget and discuss factors that have led to recent decisions and cut-backs.

Attendees will have an opportunity to work in small groups to develop follow-up questions and a panel of school and elected officials will be on hand to respond. In addition to Ms. Roberts, the panel will include Superintendent Faron Hollinger; Jean McCutcheon, chief financial officer for the Baldwin County Public Schools; Frank Trione, District I representative, Baldwin County Board of Education; State Representative Randy Davis; and Baldwin County Commissioners Ed Bishop and Wayne Gruenloh.
